Our Commitment to Protect Your Privacy

Your privacy is important to us. This privacy policy explains the personal data Clarity Global processes, how Clarity Global processes it, and for what purposes. It is in line with EU and Canada privacy laws such as General Data Protection Regulation and the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA). This policy should be read together with the Terms of Use for Clarity Global products and services. Where there is a conflict, this policy will prevail. This policy applies to all customers and visitors of www.clarityglobalinc.com.

This Privacy Policy applies in addition to and does not limit our rights and obligations under Canadian and other applicable laws.

By accessing or using any of our Services, you accept and signify your consent to the practices described in this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with the policies and practices contained in this Privacy Policy, your choice is not to use this Site or the Services in connection with this Site.

Personal Information We Collect

When you visit the Site, we automatically collect certain information about your device, including information about your web browser, IP address, time zone, and some of the cookies that are installed on your device. Additionally, as you browse the Site, we collect information about the individual web pages or products that you view, what websites or search terms referred you to the Site, and information about how you interact with the Site. We refer to this automatically-collected information as "Device Information."

We collect Device Information using the following technologies:

– "Cookies" are data files that are placed on your device or computer and often include an anonymous unique identifier. For more information about cookies and how to disable cookies, visit <http://www.allaboutcookies.org>.

– "Log files" track actions occurring on the Site, and collect data, including your IP address and date/time stamps.

Additionally, when you open an account, we collect certain information from you, including your name, residential address, date of birth, and profession, as it is required by the governing law of our operation. We refer to this information as "Account opening Information."

When making a transaction through the Site, we may collect certain information from you, including beneficiary name, address, purpose (including credit card numbers), email address, and phone number. We refer to this information as "Transfer Information."

When we talk about "Personal Information" in this Privacy Policy, we are talking both about Account Opening Information and Transfer Information and referring to it as "Client information."

How Do We Use Your Personal Information?

We use the Client Information that we generally collect to open the account for the client and remit the funds of the client's order placed through the Site (including processing your transfer information and providing you with transfer confirmations).



Additionally, we use this Order Information to:

- Communicate with you;
- To provide you with requested services;
- To manage your account with Clarity Global;
- To respond to questions, comments, or concerns regarding Clarity Global;
- Screen our transactions for potential risk or fraud; and
- When in line with the preferences you have shared with us, provide you with information or advertising relating to our products or services.

We use the Device Information that we collect to help us screen for potential risk and fraud (in particular, your IP address) and, more generally, to improve and optimise our Site (for example, by generating analytics about how our customers browse and interact with the Site, and to assess the success of our marketing and advertising campaigns). We may also use your device information in order to provide you with targeted advertisements or marketing communications we believe may be of interest to you.

Information About Your Use of the Clarity Global Services

Usage and Automatically Collected Information

When you access or use our Services, we automatically collect information about you, including Financial Information: We collect financial information related to your use of the Services.

Log Information: We collect log information about your use of the Services, including the access times, pages viewed, and your IP address.

Device Information: We collect information about the computer or mobile device you use

Activities on the Site: We collect records of activities on the Site, including your account details, the time, value, and currency of any deposit or transaction made, and the payment method.

Location Information: In accordance with your device permissions, we may collect information about the geolocation of your device.

Information Collected by Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies: We use different technologies to collect information, including cookies. You can find out more about Clarity Global's use of cookies and similar technologies in our Cookie Policy.

Sharing Your Personal Information

We share your Personal Information with third parties to help us use your Personal Information, as described above. For example, we may be asked by banks to share your information related to a transaction connected to you.

We also share your Personal Information to comply with applicable laws and regulations, to respond to a subpoena, search warrant, or other lawful request for information we receive, or to otherwise protect our rights.

Finally, we use all your transaction information for reporting it to the relevant authorities per the requirement of our licence.



Sharing Information Outside Canada

We may use cloud storage to store the personal information we hold about you. The cloud storage and the IT servers may be located outside Canada.

We may also disclose personal information to third-party suppliers and service providers located overseas for the purpose of providing the service you have requested.

Third-Party Billing

We may work with agents, service providers, affiliates, or other third-party providers that store and receive data, reports, and other user information sent by your browser or mobile device, including the pages you visit, your use of our Site, your use of third-party applications, and other information that we may use to analyse and improve the Site or the Services. These third parties may use both temporary and permanent cookies. We do not have control over how third parties use your information. We will not be liable for any loss resulting from the use of personal information by third parties. Please check their websites for information about how third parties use your information.

Our Site or Services may contain links to third-party websites. We are not responsible for the way third-party websites collect or use your personal identification information or user information. We encourage you to review the privacy policies of third-party websites that you visit or use, including those you interact with through our Site or Services.

Your Rights

If you are a European resident, you have the right to access the personal information we hold about you and to ask that your personal information be corrected, updated, or deleted. If you would like to exercise this right, please contact us through the contact information below.

Additionally, if you are a European resident, we note that we are processing your information in order to fulfil contracts we might have with you (for example, if you make an order through the Site) or otherwise to pursue our legitimate business interests listed above. Additionally, please note that your information will be transferred outside of Europe, including to Canada.

In addition, if you reside in the European Economic Area or Switzerland, you also have the following rights:
